PATRIOT’S COVE:

On June 30th, Barnegat Township’s first all inclusive affordable housing complex will officially open. The Mignatti Group & Penrose Properties will have a ribbon cutting at the Patriot’s Cove Apartments at 4 PM. The complex is located directly across from the A&P Plaza on Route 9 on Union Blvd.

HORIZON DRAINAGE BASIN:

The Township has received word from the bonding company for Kara Homes, that the 2nd drainage basin will soon be repaired. Sambol Construction will be performing the repairs and I’m sure the Horizon homeowners will be happy to finally have this last piece of the Kara bankruptcy finally resolved.

MENK REPAIRS:

Repairs to the remaining 277 Menk homes have begun on both the crawlspaces and the attics. I and other Township officials will be addressing these homeowners at a special meeting this week.
